A survey has been conducted in order to find out about students' motivation for studying abroad. Bachelor and Master degree students were asked to name the reasons for studying abroad. The aim of this report is to outline general trends and describe possible further development of the situation.

MAIN CHANGES

As the figures show, the majority of students of both categories believe that studying abroad is beneficial for future career opportunities. Similarly, the same ~~number~~ number (16%) of both bachelor and master degree students think that studying abroad helps to form an unbiased opinion about other cultures and their values, although this number is relatively small in comparison to others. As for ~~the~~ the rest of the (mentioned by students) reasons, several shifts have been discovered. Firstly, the number of students who see studying abroad as a way to improve their language skills

decreases slightly when they begin to study for a master degree. Furthermore, only 5% of master degree students ~~mentioned~~ increased ~~travelling opportunities~~ maturity, while 21% of bachelors said about it. ~~However, the~~ ~~more students~~ ~~consider travelling opportunities~~ ~~for~~ ~~studying for a master degree.~~ more students consider travelling opportunities while studying for a master degree.

The main reason behind forementioned changes might be more realistic views of master degree students.
